To All Hampton Property Owners:

The Hampton Assessor's Office is currently conducting Cyclical and Sales Inspections as part of the process associated with the 2016 town-wide revaluation which is now underway. These inspections require us to physically visit each and every property in Hampton and our goal in doing so is to ensure that all properties in Hampton are treated equally, with fair and equitable assessments that are reasonably proportioned so all taxpayers are contributing their fair share of support for the services they receive.

We are requesting your assistance in completing these tasks in accordance with New Hampshire State Statute Chapter 75, or more specifically, RSA 75:8 and RSA 75:8a, which requires us to complete a review of all properties at least once every five years or sooner if necessary. As part of this process representatives from our office, **Jared Hynes** and **Charlene Genest**, will be visiting your property and can be identified by **picture ID's issued by the Hampton Police Department**. The purpose of the visit is to verify the accuracy of the data that currently exists on your property card. They will complete an exterior review verifying the measurements of all improvements that currently exist on your property and will also be requesting an opportunity to inspect the interior of your home or business.
