

Hampton Conservation Commission

January 26, 1976

The Chairman, Nelson Grant, opened the meeting at eight fifteen, with Edna Pearl Parr, Irene Palmer, Ruth Stimson and Ruth Nutter present. The minutes of the October 27th meeting were read and approved.

Ruth Nutter made the motion, seconded by Edna Pearl, that the 1976 dues of \$80 be paid to the N. H. Association of Conservation Commissions. This was voted unanimously.

Under new business, Nelson brought the application of Ronald Dube for discussion. This application was for a walkway over marsh ^{a plat form} grass, 16' by 12', 75' in length, plus a wharf. This was planned to be from his cottage to the water.

After discussion, Ruth Nutter made the motion, seconded by Irene, that the application not be recommended by our Commission. This passed by a unanimous vote, and Nelson gave the Secretary a draft he had already composed to be sent to Mr. McGee, with whatever changes our discussion would add to it.

The Secretary called attention to a letter from SPACE asking for a donation to the Environmental Coalition, which is working to enhance New Hampshire's human and natural resources. Edna Pearl made a motion, seconded by Ruth Stimson, that our Treasurer be instructed to send SPACE \$25. This was passed unanimously.

The next meeting will be held at the Library
on Monday evening, February 23rd.
The meeting was adjourned at nine O' clock.
