

Hampton Conservatio Commission

August 8th, 1977

Our Chairman, Nelson Grant, opened this special meeting with Al Lavallee, Neil MacPherson, Irene Palmer, and Ruth Nutter present.

The members agreed that a Public Informational Hearing should be held on the application of Kenneth A. Traves to dredge and fill at 561 Ocean Blvd., the plan submitted to dredge 30,900 cu. yds. and fill 31,060 cu. yds.

It was decided to hold the hearing on Monday evening at seven thirty, at the Hampton Academy Junior High School, in the Cafetorium, and the Secretary was to have a notice in the Hampton Union and the Portsmouth Herald, and take care of all other

necessary correspondence, and to arrange for a Secretary to take notes of the meeting, both for our records, and for the office of George McGee. There will be a public hearing on this matter in Mr. McGee's office in Concord on Sept. 6th.

Mr. McGee also held a public hearing in Concord on August 16th, at one thirty P. M. concerning the application of Glenn Bosworth, to fill at 536 High Street, and Neil MacPherson agreed to attend this meeting.

This meeting was adjourned at 9:30.

At the close of the public hearing, Nelson did not feel that we would need to meet again in August, unless something unforeseen came up, so that our next meeting will be the usual fourth Monday, September 26th.
