

CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING

May 25, 1993

The meeting was called to order by Acting Chairman Peter Tilton, Jr., at 7:10 p.m. Also in attendance were Peg Lawrence, Vivianne Marcotte, Sheila Nudd and Alberta True.

The Minutes of May 4, 1993 were approved. Ms. Marcotte motioned to approve the Minutes, seconded by Peg Lawrence. All were in favor.

Conrad & Patricia Stone

Conrad & Patricia Stone addressed the Commission. This was a follow-up to a site walk held on Tuesday, May 18th. This application was for repairing a stone wall with gunite and finished rocks. Ms. Marcotte motioned not to oppose the application, seconded by Ms. True. All were in favor. A letter will be sent to the Wetlands Board.

Walter Demers, Ray Lavin, Robert Saltmarsh

Messrs. Demers, Lavin and Saltmarsh addressed the Commission. This application was for capping the sea wall to help keep the water from going back between the homes. Ms. Lawrence asked questions regarding the capping procedures. Ms. Lawrence motioned not to oppose the application, seconded by Ms. Nudd. All were in favor. A letter will be sent to the Wetlands Board.

Mr. Tilton stated that the petition for Daniel P. Wake, 800 Hunter Street was withdrawn. He also stated that the permit was issued by the Wetland Board for Bouchard. The Coups also received a permit from the Wetlands Board.

Mr. Tilton mentioned that Mr. Bunker had sent a letter to the Wetlands Board not to oppose the Dept. of Transportation application.

Mr. Tilton handed out applications regarding Fresh Water Wetlands for those that might be interested in attending. This is a workshop for teachers and youth leaders sponsored by UNH Cooperative Extension and New Hampshire Fish and Game Department. This is to be held on July 14, 1993, 9:30 - 3:30 in Dover, N.H.

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Mr. Tilton also handed out Complaint Forms from the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services to be used if a Commissioner witnesses a possible violation.

Mr. Tilton stated that Mr. Bunker had contacted Christine Sanders of the New Hampshire Lobster Company but has not heard back from her regarding fill on the dune grass.

Mr. Tilton handed out information that Mr. Weber put together regarding the bird houses.

Mr. Clifford joined the meeting at this time.

Ms. Lawrence gave an update on the wall at her property. Dori Wiggin visited Ms. Lawrence and evaluated the wall. Dori will send a letter to Mr. Downing at the Wetlands Board with her findings.

A discussion ensued regarding Ms. Marcotte's property where she lost several trees in the storm. Mr. Tilton stated this was an area outside the State's Wetlands buffer. Ms. Marcotte will check with Dori.

Ms. Marcotte motioned to adjourn, seconded by Ms. Nudd.
All in favor to adjourn at 8:15.
