

CONSERVATION COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING

OCTOBER 24, 1995

The meeting was called to order by Vivianne G. Marcotte, Chairperson, at 7:05 p.m. Also in attendance were Bonnie Thimble, Peter Tilton, Jr., Alberta True and Dave Weber. Alternates attending were Betty Callanan, sitting in for Reid Bunker and Irene Palmer, sitting in for Jim Clifford.

Ms. Marcotte stated that Mr. Clifford had sent a letter of resignation to the Hampton Selectmen effective immediately. Ms. Palmer, who is an Alternate, will fill Mr. Clifford's slot until April, 1996. Ms. Marcotte also stated that Mr. Dan Gangai will be coming on board as a Commissioner soon.

The Minutes of September 26, 1995 were reviewed and approved. Mr. Weber motioned to approve the minutes, seconded by Ms. True. All in favor.

Wetland Applications:

None at this time.

Referrals:

Ms. Marcotte stated that Rallis will be on next month's agenda.

Ms. Marcotte stated the drainage plans submitted by the First National Bank of Portsmouth, High St., were reviewed and no substantial change was noted from existing conditions. A memo will be forwarded to the Planning Board.

Ms. Marcotte read a letter from Atty. Tetler regarding Richard Moore, 184 North Shore Rd., Hampton, vs. State Wetlands. The issue is the issuance of a wetland permit to fill in said lot. This matter is in the courts. We will be notified of Wetlands Board's Hearing.

Wetland Issues/Actions

Bob Preston - received permit.

John Hangen - approved. Change of name on permit from Rush to Hangen.

Arlene Legere - Wetlands Board's Public Hearing was held on October 10th.

Holiday Shores - approved with conditions.

Hartnett - received after-the-fact permit.

Projects:

Salt Marsh Marker

Ms. Callanan, in Mr. Bunker's absence, gave an update on the marker. The marker is cemented in place and there were boulders placed in front to prevent driving too close to the marker. Ruth Stimpson would like to see the landscaping done. A discussion ensued on plans for a dedication. It was tentatively decided to have the dedication on Veteran's Day, Saturday, Nov. 11th. Ms. Marcotte will discuss with Mr. Bunker and the Selectmen.

Victory Garden

Ms. Thimble gave a brief update on the Victory Garden. The water will be shut off on October 25, 1995. There are still some vegetables growing despite of a recent frost.

Ms. Marcotte stated that the budget for 1996 was submitted to Hunter Reiseberg, Town Manager.

Ms. Marcotte received a letter from Gove Environmental regarding mitigation monitoring for Nigrelli - Riverwalk.

Ms. Marcotte read a memo she sent to the Planning Board regarding the Besman issue.

Ms. Marcotte, Ms. Thimble, Ms. Callanan investigated a complaint on the Wasson property. She has asked Mr. Wasson to send her a copy of the delineation done on his property a year or so ago. A short discussion ensued.

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Ms. Marcotte mentioned that the N.H. Conservation Commission Meeting will be held on Nov. 4, 1995, in Concord. Ms. Marcotte, Ms. Thimble, Ms. True and Ms. Palmer are considering attending.

Ms. Marcotte reviewed several upcoming workshops and meetings.

Ms. Marcotte also reviewed the calls she received for the month.

Treasurer's Report

Ms. Launi gave the Treasurer's Report. There is currently \$15,694.67 in the Conservation Account.

Mr. Weber gave an update on the bird houses.

Ordinance

Ms. Marcotte suggested the Commissioners start on the Ordinance at this meeting. It was suggested that she make arrangements with Steve Bird to go over this Ordinance.

The next regular meeting will be held on Tuesday, November 28, 1995, at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Selectmen's Room. The site walk will be on Saturday, November 25, 1995, at 9:00 p.m. meeting at the Town Parking Lot.

Mr. Tilton motioned to adjourn at 8:50 p.m., seconded by Mr. Weber. All were in favor.
