

CONSERVATION COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING
July 22, 2003

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Greg Smart, Chairperson. Present were Bonnie Thimble, Peter Tilton Jr., and Dr. Ralph Falk. Absent were Heather Day, Ellen Goethel, and Daniel Gangai. Alternate attending was Jay Diener sitting in for Ellen Goethel. Alternate Fred Palazzolo was absent.

The Minutes of June 24, 2003 were reviewed. All were in agreement with the corrections noted.

NH WETLAND BUREAU APPLICATIONS

A. Michael McDermott
141 Island Path

This is a minimum impact expedited application for the construction of a 12' x 24' above ground pool in second 50' of tidal buffer. After a brief discussion, Mr. Tilton motioned not to oppose the application, seconded by Mr. Diener. All were in favor.

B. William Zamberardi
555 Winnacunnet Rd.

This is a Standard Dredge & Fill Application for grading and improvements to driveway. Overlay and extension of existing paved driveway located to the west of the house. Construction of a new paved driveway to the north of the house. Placement of 2 plus to 12 plus inches of loam along the westerly and easterly sides of the house and along the southerly side of the back porch. Placing loam in isolated areas for footing protection and planting beds. Placement of compacted structural fill for new reconstructed driveway. After a brief presentation and discussion, Mr. Diener motioned not to oppose both the the wetland application and the special permit with the conditions that silt fencing be used and the Commission be notified upon start and completion of project. This was seconded by Mr. Tilton. All were in favor.

C. Henry & Mary Jo Stonie
1050 Ocean Blvd

This is a standard dredge and fill (after-the-fact) application for maintenance of the seawall. This is for informational only.

D. Marco Rotundo
8 Mohawk

The project is requesting to move three (3) wetland buffer zone markers in line with two (2) other markers to form a straight line. Part of this area would be filled in with gravel. After a brief discussion, Mr. Tilton motioned to recommend denial of the application as it totally against the spirit and intent of the wetland ordinance and for that reason may not be granted. (2.3.5B) This was seconded by Ms. Thimble. All were in favor.
