

CONSERVATION COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING

Thursday, January 3, 2008

FINAL

The Public Hearing was called to order at 7:10 p.m. by Chairperson Ellen Goethel at the Hampton Office Upstairs Meeting Room. Present were Commission Members Jay Diener, Nathan Page. Alternate Barbara Renaud attended sitting in for Daniel Gangai. Conservation Commission Coordinator Steve Scaturro was present.

Mrs. Goethel opened the Public Hearing for RSA41:14A Ice Pond Dam, Tax Nap 96, Lot 1 regarding dam across Nilus Brook. There were no public comments and the following motions were made:

1. Mr. Page motioned to purchase the dam from Malcolm Smith for \$10,000 plus associated expenses from the Conservation Fund and to accept the easements set forth in the Purchase & Sales Agreement, Page 1 thru 4, under description beginning with "Smith shall convey to the Commission the following:" and including Sections A, B, C, D and E. Mr. Diener seconded the motion. All were in favor.
2. Mr. Diener motioned to advise the Board of Selectmen that we are recommending relinquishing via the RSA41:14A process, the existing easements on Lot 96-1-0 to the owner of that property. Ms. Renaud seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Since there were no public comments, Mrs. Goethel closed the Public Hearing.

The Commissioners reviewed the Town Report and made changes as necessary.

Invasive species were discussed regarding Ice Pond.

Mr. Page motioned to adjourn at 8:30 p.m., seconded by Mr. Diener. All were in favor.
