



Administration

- 1st ever JOP w/ Town of Hampton agreed upon in 2012.
- MOA with Hampton Beach Village District.
- Seacoast Regional manager position requested in budget.
- Division closed it's Made in NH Store and an RFP was issued for space reuse.
- Entered into agreements with multiple local caterers to serve the Seashell Complex.
- Audit completed on meter operations. Recommendations substantially implemented.
- Ordered security system for the Seashell following consultation with Police Chief.
- WEBCAM installed on the Seashell roof through the HBVD for public viewing at HamptonBeach.org.
- Entered into an agreement with WMUR for their live shot camera and reporter plug in.
- Worked with Hampton Fire Chief Chris Silver in delivering specific weather forecasts to help planning
- In discussions with Fire Department to establish a Fire Net wireless system.
- Installed new equipment to extend radio reach of lifeguards. (Continuing to improve and extend reach with new radio repeater being installed at North Beach Bathhouse).

Park Operations

- Put out more recycling bins to increase recycling efforts.
- New signage for parking meters in place for this season.
- Purchased a new Beach Rake to ensure beach stays clean and that will reduce sand collected. Also retrofitted back-up surf rake to reduce sand collection
- Purchased Lifeguard ATV, Skid Steer, Snow blower.
- Exploring options to buy trash truck.
- Extended Lifeguard hours in 2012 to cover rip currents
- Earlier bathroom opening times to accommodate public use
- Extensive clean up following winter storm.
- Prison Labor was used for cleaning of landscape beds in fall 2012 and spring 2013.

Facility Management

- Trained HBVD entertainment staff on operation of stage lighting and increasing the flexibility of the stage lighting which will allow more diverse performances (Like Dance recitals, Plays etc) next season.
- Installing intrusion system for primary buildings and some internet based cameras inside.
- Kitchen renovation and upgrade in process seashell to serve multiple caterers.
- New sign being developed to make the CPA lot more conspicuous.
- Supplemental plantings in landscape beds in the fall of 2012, \$30,000.

- Sand Cleanup Spring A.J. Coleman and Son Inc. \$24,922
- Cobble Removal at North Beach by DOT ongoing as of today
