

Hampton Conservation Committee

July 15th, 1971

Chairman Peter Randall called the meeting to order at 8:05.

The following members were present:

The letters received from Senators McIntyre, and Cotton, and Congressman Wyman were read by Peter. He mentioned that the plans for the Aerial survey were progressing. A new method of garbage and rubbish pick up and disposal was described by Peter, which would involve surrounding towns, within a 25 mile radius. A letter was to be written concerning this Commission taking an active role in the recycling project. It was the opinion of the members that this was not exactly in our line of endeavors.

Under new business, the committee chosen to compile the material for the town survey agreed to meet together Thursday evening, the 12th. Ruth Stimson made the motion that the questionnaire be tested by all members of the Commission. The method of getting these questionnaires into the homes in Hampton was discussed. It was suggested that possibly members of the various clubs in Hampton could be of assistance in this matter. The next scheduled meeting will be on Aug. 19th. Meeting was adjourned at nine fifteen.
