

Hampton Conservation Commission

March 25th, 1974

Chairman Nelson Grant, Ruth Stimson, Stillman Hobbs, Peter Randall and Ruth Nutter met at the Lane Memorial Library on March 25th, at eight P. M. The method of appointment ~~of~~ a member of the Conservation Committee to the Planning Board Committee of seven was discussed. It was stated that the Selectmen considered it their duty to make this decision, and referring to material from the state, our commission felt that we appointed this representative from our own membership.

The Secretary read the minutes of the February 25th meeting, which were approved as read.

Ruth submitted the Treasurer's report as the same as our last meeting, \$874.18, which was accepted.

Ruth noted that a written request to the Town Manager was required, in order for our Commission to receive the five hundred dollars, to which the voters agreed at Town Meeting in March, as our budgetary allotment.

Ruth also informed us that on April 17th, Dr. Arthur Mason will be in our county to explain and answer questions on how to implement Mosquito Control, and anyone interested may talk with him in her office in Brentwood.

Peter noted that Article 4 on the Town Warrant on his amendment, passed--confirming that any tidal or fresh water marshland acquired thru tax ~~land~~<sup>deed</sup>, will not be sold, but held under the control of the Conservation Commission. Our Commission may receive gifts of land, if approved.

Ruth brought in three beautifully detailed maps, showing respectively Wetlands--Residential and Open areas, and a Soil Survey.

Peter said that the Wheelabrator Frye Co., had purchased land near Towle Road, and had given our Commission an easement on three acres of upland. Continuing with this subject, Peter would like to start an easement program adjoining Taylor River, near Gary Hurd's property.

Due to the fact that Ruth Stimson's and Nelson Grant's term on the Commission expires this Spring, it was voted to name Ruth Mutter acting Chairman until our next meeting only, which date was set at on April 29th. She will notify all members of this date, and most hopefully, this same group will be greeting one another, and continue their dedicated work on this Commission.

The meeting was adjourned at nine o'clock.
