

Hampton Conservation Commission

June 28th, 1976

The Chairman, Nelson Grant, opened the meeting at 8:00 P. M. with Ednapearl Parr, Alide Lavallee Neil MacPherson, Edmund Loughlin, and Irene Palmer present.

The Secretary's report was read and accepted as read.

It was voted to dispense with the Treasurer's statement since Ed had only just received the material from the previous treasurer.

Ednapearl reported on fill behind the St. Magnus Condominiums. She had talked on the telephone with Verne Knowles of the Special Board Water Resources. There is a "cease and desist" order on Fred Schaake. The fill will have to be taken out.

Ednapearl moved that the Secretary write a letter to the Special Board Water Resources that Mr. Schaake is continuing to fill on North Beach Road behind St. Magnus Condominiums, and would they please take necessary action to stop the filling. Ed seconded, motion carried.

Neil will take a picture of the fill. Irene will try to get a picture from a condominium resident.

Ed questioned the progress of the Farr petition on 1A. Ednapearl said he has permission to fill 100 feet back.

There was discussion about the Quinlan development on 1A. Ed, as a member of the Planning Board, gave some information.

Al: Areas of likely open space and protection.  
(Formerly done by Stillman Hobbs)  
Irene: Scenic Roads, Acquisition of land.

The rough drafts of letters of appreciation to Stillman Hobbs and Ruth Stimson were read and approved.

Nelson discussed areas of assignment. The following assignments were agreed upon:

Ednapearl: Legislative information and communication.

Neil: Indexing and mapping of open spaces, wetlands, critical areas, etc., (Formerly done by Ruth Stimson)

Ruth: Public releases, notification, community information. *INFORMATIONAL MEETINGS*

Ed: Flood plains, insurance information. "No insurance protection from ocean storms", according to Ed.

Nelson: Actions on applications for fill, dredge removal of fill.

Neil asked about status of Bicentennial Park.

Ednapearl gave a brief history and stated that it is used all the time by the people.

Ednapearl said the State of N. H. has not acted on "land-use". The Federal Government will tell us where we can build beginning 1977.

Nelson asked about aerial photos of Hampton. Ed said they are kept in Bldg. Inspector's office and are available.

Next meeting will be July 26th, at 8:00 P. M.
