

Hampton Conservation Commission

July 26th, 1976

The Chairman, Nelson Grant, opened the meeting at eight fifteen, with Irene Palmer, Neil MacPherson, and Ruth Nutter present.

The minutes of the June 28th meeting were read and accepted as read.

Under old business, Neil reported that he had talked to Ruth Stimson on the phone, concerning his assignment of indexing and mapping of open spaces and wetlands, and that she had given him much information on both that subject and related concerns of this Commission. After general discussion, he was advised to channel his efforts in one area at a time, for the present.

Irene spoke of her assignment, stressing scenic roads and right of way roads. Ruth showed the members a copy of the Conservation Easement given this Commission by the heirs of Harry E. Chase, subject to a Warranty Deed from Wheelabrator-Frye, and made the suggestion that at least some of us should walk this Easement and know its exact location and appearance. Irene offered to contact Wheelabrator-Frye and set a date convenient to them to indicate the exact location, and Ruth will accompany her. It was further noted that possibly Ashton Norton might give us information concerning public roads giving access to the beach at Plaice Cove, which have been marked "Private Way" illegally. Ruth spoke of her assignment and noted that she would include writing the article that is

also recommended disapproval.

printed in the Annual Town Report.

Neil spoke of a meeting to be held in Rye on July 27th, to discuss an amendment to the fill and dredge law on the marshes, as it is necessary to make a ditch in the marshes, to avoid standing pools of water, for mosquito control. He plans to attend this meeting.

Nelson spoke of his desire for all members to be aware of their assignments at all times, and to assume responsibility for continuous activity individually, in order that each will enjoy a more thorough knowledge of the workings of this Commission, and feel an active participation in it's decisions.

New Business: Nelson read an application for "Fill and Dredge" from Norman L. Rochette, 4 Lovell St., Nashua. This is Lot 20, ^(BLK-R) BLK at Bragg Ave, Hampton Beach, 1422 Cu. Yards of fill, purpose, a camp.

After discussion, the secretary was instructed to write to George McGee, proposing that the request be denied. Ruth also was to send four pictures from Mrs. Amman, at St. Magnus Condominium, plus three that Neil took, showing the continued fill that Mr. Fred Schaake is placing behind the Condominium, to Mr. McGee, asking him to pursue the matter further.

In regard to Mr. Rochette's application, Irene made the motion, seconded by Ruth, and voted unanimously, on the above recommendation.

The next meeting will be on August 23rd.

This meeting was adjourned at 9:25.
