

Hampton Conservation Commission

September 17, 1979

Peter Randall, Chairman, opened the meeting at eight o'clock with Irene Palmer, Neil MacPherson, Nelson Grant and Ruth Nutter in attendance. Peter announced that Sandra Gurick has resigned from the Commission due to a heavy personal schedule. The Secretary's report was read and accepted as read. In giving the Treasurer's report, Neil stated that he had given the Secretary \$5.00 for stamps, leaving a balance on hand of \$3840.90. From petty cash, he gave the Secretary \$1.18 for two note pads.

Old Business: The Selectmen's project of the three new sewer interceptors was discussed in detail, namely the Northeast interceptor with pump station and force main, Brown Avenue interceptor, and Church St. pump station and force main. It was decided that this was a necessary procedure, and that the Secretary would write a letter of approval composed by Peter, asking that we be kept informed as the project continues. Nelson will take the letter to the public meeting to be held Thursday evening, Sept. 20th. Neil and Irene will also attend this meeting.

Peter told us that the Wetlands Board has three new members.

Peter has been notified that our 1979 Budget request is currently due, and after studying last years, the following changes were suggested: to increase the Accumulation Fund from \$1000 to \$1500; Environmental Coalition from \$25 to \$100; and Telephone, from \$40 to \$50. Ruth will type the

budget request and give it to the Town Manager before October 12th.

Peter feels that this Commission could well use a four draw filing cabinet, which, hopefully we could place in the Town office, locked. We already have much material to store in it, and he is going to look into price etc.

Ruth had received a letter from Loren Hutchins, asking for any suggestions for the Planning Board in regard to setting up a Sounding Board, with related points on Conservation. As the deadline had already passed, we could not follow through with this. However, Ruth volunteered to call Loren and to tell him that we would like to join the Planning Board at their meetings, or have them # join us at our meetings.

↑ Peter has received a petition for dredge and fill from Ronald Dube, near Smith and Gilmore. He is requesting permission to fill 55 cubic yards of crushed stone, for a boat ramp. Nelson is going to contact him for further information.

Ruth was to find out if the Planning Board had worked on maps or indexed open lands.

Our next meeting will be on Monday evening, October 22nd. This meeting was adjourned at ten O' clock.
