

HAMPTON CONSERVATION COMMISSION
Minutes of Meeting
September 25, 1986

The Hampton Conservation Commission met in the Lane Memorial Library on September 25, 1986. (The Commission did not meet in August.)

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

The Chairman informed the members that the Grenier application at Hampton Beach had been turned down by the Hampton Planning Board.

Mr. Barkley will attend the 1986 Natural Resources Lecture Series at the Rockingham County Complex in Brentwood on October 23, 30 and November 6. (Telephone No. 772-4385)

Mr. Gilmore spoke in regard to an application to the New Hampshire Wetlands Board by Pier Properties to place fill in a 3,000 square foot low area on Harbor Road opposite the Marina. (The members of Pier Properties are Ray Gilmore, Arlene Gilmore, John Foote and Shirley Foote.) Mr. Prescott voiced objections. The Chairman said that he had inspected the area with Dr. Frank Richardson and Mr. Robert Prokop of the Wetlands Board. The fill would have minor impact. Mr. Bridle moved that the Commission has no objection to the fill as described in the application. Mr. Barkley seconded. The vote was 5-0-0, unanimous. Note: Regarding any application for reclassification by Pier Properties, the Commission voted 5-0-0 to recommend reclassification as previously filled land on the above mentioned land.

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Mrs. Woodman spoke about her problem with water flowing down Drakes River onto her land causing flooding. She showed maps and pictures. Mr. Barkley moved that the Hampton Conservation Commission having received further information concerning the tide gates on Drakes River in the Town of Hampton modifies its recommendations of July 24, 1986 to state that the Commission takes no position on this matter at this time. Mr. Bridle seconded. The vote was 4-0-1

The next meeting will be October 23, 1986 at 7:00 p.m.
