

CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING

May 4, 1993

The meeting was called to order by Chairman A. Reid Bunker, at 7:05 p.m. Also in attendance were Rev. Robert Golledge, Peg Lawrence, Vivianne Marcotte, Peter Tilton, Jr., and Alberta True.

The Minutes of March 23, 1993 were approved. Ms. Marcotte motioned to approve the Minutes, seconded by Rev. Golledge with five in favor and one opposed.

Gauron Pier

A site walk was conducted before the meeting to view a proposed pier by the Gaurons on the Hampton River. It was the consensus of the Commissioners to oppose any application. Mr. Bunker will send a letter to Bob Burns, the Engineer who met us at the site. This opposition is due to the fact that it is in a congested area between the State and Smith and Gilmore piers. Wetlands Applications

To follow-up on the Wetland Application of the April 27th Meeting, a motion was made from Rev. Golledge not to oppose the Coulp Application, seconded by Ms. Marcotte. All were in favor. Mr. Bunker will write a letter to the Wetlands Board and copy to the Applicant.

Philip Palmer Trust

To follow-up on the Wetland Application of the April 27th Meeting, a motion was made by Ms. Marcotte not to oppose the Application seconded by Ms. Lawrence. There were six voting in favor with one abstaining.

Mr. Bunker stated that Committee Reports will be reviewed at the next regular meeting.

Mr. Bunker stated he had invited the Town Manager to the next regular meeting on the 25th of May.

The Household Hazardous Waste Collection will be on Saturday, May 8, 1993 at 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. The collection will be held at the Town Office Parking Lot.

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Mr. Bunker gave an update on the Sicard property off Josephine Drive after talking with Dori Wiggin.

Mr. Bunker sent four intervention letters to the Wetlands Board. The Applications were for: Demers, Dennett, Saltmarsh Realty Trust and Robert Saltmarsh. The applications involved the improvements to the retaining wall to the rear of their properties on the ocean side. A discussion ensued on this issue. Mr. Tilton suggested that the Applicants come to the next meeting with detailed proposal of what they intend to do. Mr. Bunker will invite them to the next meeting.

Site Walks

N.H. Lobster Pound

A site walk was done before this meeting to view this area. An area was filled over dune grass. Mr. Bunker stated that Dori Wiggin will be invited to view this area in the near future. Mr. Weber will try to get the owners name to Mr. Bunker.

Bragg Ave.

An area next to the river was filled in and the ownership is in question. Mr. Bunker will follow-up with Fred Clews Jr. on the pier and filled area.

Ms. Lawrence asked about a site walk in back of her property. Mr. Bunker suggested she contact Mary Power for a meeting with Dori Wiggin.

Ms. Marcotte motioned to adjourn, seconded by Rev. Colledge. All were in favor. Meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
