

CONSERVATION COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING

The Minutes of November 28th, 1995 were reviewed. Mr. Tilton motioned to approve the Minutes, seconded by Mr. Kowalski. All were in favor.

The Besman application was postponed till the January Conservation Meeting. A short discussion ensued.

Mr. Peter Stern's membership was not voted on by the Selectmen and Ms. Marcotte will inform Mr. Stern by letter.

Ms. Marcotte mentioned that Tuholski 's \$800.00 fine was held in abeyance until the restoration is done.

Ms Marcotte stated that Ellen Lavin, Town Treasurer, issued a check in the amount of \$750.00 for payment of the salt marsh marker.

The remainder of the meeting was devoted to reviewing the Wetlands Ordinance which must be submitted to the Planning Board.

The next regular meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 23, 1996 at 7:00 p.m. in the Selectmen's Room. The site walk will be held on Saturday, January 20, 1996, at 9:00 a.m. meeting in the Town Parking Lot.
