

Minutes of 10/13/10 meeting of the Hampton Mosquito Control Commission

Present: Ann Kaiser, Rich Reniere, Russ Bernstein

Meeting called to order at 6:05pm

\$8,162 surplus for 2010 reflected a lower need for adulticiding.

The new Board of Selectmen requirement for every sub-contractor to have an additional (Part B) \$1,000,000 in workers' compensation insurance may result in higher bids from the subs. Rich will ask the Budget Committee to look into whether the cost of increasing the town's coverage to include the subs would result in lower overall costs for the taxpayers.

The BOS still deciding whether to include full cost of HMCC budget in the town budget, obviating the need for a warrant article.

Ann will ask Dragon for a quote to build 20 more greenhead traps to replace old and broken ones. We agreed that if the price was less than \$4,000, Ann could OK it.

Ann will submit application to the Dept of Health and Human Services to see if we can get a refund, since she was told that funds were available. She will emphasize the benefit the tourists bring to this area.
