

Minutes, Hampton Mosquito Control Commission meeting of October 18, 2012  
at Lane Memorial Library

Convened at 7:00pm

In Attendance: Ann Kaiser & Richard Reniere

Absent: Russ Bernstein

After careful review of the two proposals received for contract work of controlling mosquitoes within the Hampton District, the commissioners in attendance voted to award the three-year contract to Dragon Mosquito Control, pending approval by the Board of Selectmen. The absent commissioner later agreed with this decision by phone.

Ann reported that, after contacting the vendor about the best way to repair tears in the greenhead fly trap tent door, duct tape applied to both sides would work fine. A replacement door can be purchased eventually, if needed.

The September reports from Dragon stated that no mosquito samples from Hampton, sent to the State for arboviral-disease testing, had tested positive, as of 9/30/12. However, both EEE & WNV mosquitoes had been found in other southern towns. If no further adulticiding is required in October, the HMCC will be returning just over \$4800 of unused funds to the Town.
