

Minutes, Hampton Mosquito Control Commission meeting of October 29, 2013  
at Lane Memorial Library; called to order at 6:05pm

In Attendance: Commissioners Ann Kaiser, Richard Reniere, & Russ Bernstein, plus Sarah MacGregor of Dragon Mosquito Control.

Sarah distributed the latest (Oct. 11) report from NH DHHS on the Arbovirus Testing results. This report showed that none of the mosquito batches from Hampton contained positive-testing mosquitoes, nor have there been any human or animal positive reports within Hampton.

After reviewing the final bill for contracted services, it was noted that there was enough money remaining in the budget to proceed with ordering the replacement door for the tent that stores the greenhead fly traps, as voted on at the meeting of July 30. Ann will fill out the requisition form and order the door.

Thirteen greenhead traps have been “retired”, and 8 have been repaired, leaving the total usable traps at 141. Sarah stated that the cost of new traps is \$150, down from the \$175 which was the cost in 2010. Since many of the traps are literally on their last legs and will also soon be retired, it was decided, after a lengthy discussion, to request an increase of \$3000 to the HMCC budget at the Budget Committee meeting on Nov. 5 to cover the cost of constructing 20 replacement traps. It was felt this would be preferable to a warrant article for acquiring the needed funds.

Richard will connect with Public Works to have the unusable traps hauled away.

Meeting was adjourned at 6:45pm
