Meeting called to order at 6:30pm

Minutes from the July 14th meeting passed.

Sarah at Dragon told Ann that the average life of a Greenhead trap is 10 years. Of the 150 traps we have owned since 2004, 14 were retired due to poor condition, leaving us with 136 functional traps. We had 100 traps built in 2004, 20 in 2007 and 30 this year.

Based on the average life and the cost, we decided to amend the 3-year draft proposal to ask for 25 new traps per year.

Also, the proposal will include the following items:

- The bids on the contract will be due by 9/22
- The vendor shall report on the number and conditional status of the traps

Tim O'Connor will go before the BOS to become an alternate to the HMCC.
