We are a subcommittee appointed by the Hampton Planning Board, charged with updating the Vision Chapter of the Hampton Master Plan. New Hampshire statutes prescribe a "Vision Section" (RSA 674:2), which serve to direct other sections of the plan.

This letter is to solicit your views on a "Vision for Hampton". What would you envision our Town to look like in the next 10, 15 or 20 years? Subjects you might consider are transportation, community facilities, economic development, natural resources, recreation, cultural and historic values, as well as housing and neighborhood considerations.

For example, what are your thoughts on developing Lafayette Road from Route 101 to the North Hampton bridge into a walkable, livable area populated by shopping, restaurants, services and housing?

How do you feel about creating a community complex on Academy Avenue from High Street to Winnacunnet Road? The complex would include Town offices, library, public schools, as well as facilities for youth and seniors.
