- mirrors, ceramics or Pyrex®
  - light bulbs, plates or vases
- drinking glasses, window glass
- hazardous or bio-hazardous waste
  - plastics other than those listed
    - tissues, paper towels, napkins
  - waxed paper or waxed cardboard
  - stickers or sheets of address labels (affixed address labels and stamps ok)
  - Styrofoam® or paper to-go containers



Newspapers & inserts  
(no bags)



Phone Books



Aluminum foil, pie pans, etc.  
(Must be CLEAN)



Loose metal jar lids & steel bottle caps



Corrugated cardboard & paper bags  
flatten



Paper milk/juice cartons  
no foil pouches



Paper-back books



Empty aerosol cans  
(no caps)

No need to remove: paper clips, stamps, address labels, staples, tape, wire, metal fasteners, rubber bands, spiral bindings, plastic tabs.

Please flatten all cardboard boxes.

Empty and rinse all containers.
