


Town of Hampton



Public Notice

The Hampton Board of Selectmen will hold a public comment period on the proposed amendments to Sections 1, 6, 9, 12, 13, and 15 of "Article 5 Parking Regulations" on December 10, 2012 at 7:00 PM.

Proposed amendments are available for viewing on the Town's website at www.town.hampton.nh.us under Document Central – Public Notices and the Town Manager's Office.

December 10, 2012 Amend the following sections of Articles 5 to read as follows: Deletions are double strikethrough and additions are underlined; Italicized wording provides for information related to the parking changes.

Section 1 Definitions

Overnight Parking. Shall mean the placement of any vehicle, to park any vehicle, or cause the same; whether occupied or not; to be parked on any public way, and or municipal parking lot, or municipally maintained parking lot in the Town of Hampton between (during) the hours of ~~2:00 AM and 6:00 AM~~, 1:00 AM and 7:00 AM, except in areas where designated.

The change in hours is to be consistent with the Winter Parking Ban

Section 6 Municipal Owned and Municipally Maintained Parking Lots

Public Parking Lots

Veterans of the Vietnam Conflict” Uptown Municipal Parking Lot at High Street.

~~Two Hour~~ Three (3) Hour Public Parking in parking spaces as designated and posted.

Hampton Residential Parking Lots

Overnight parking between the hours of ~~2:00 AM and 7:00 AM~~ 1:00 AM and 7:00 AM is prohibited in all residential parking lots with the following exceptions:

“Veterans of the Persian Gulf War” (King’s Highway and High Street)

Non-Residential Public Parking is allowed in parking spaces that are not designated and posted as Hampton Residential Parking between the hours of ~~7:00 AM and 10:00 PM~~ 5:00 AM and 1:00 AM

Overnight Parking is prohibited during the hours of 1:00 AM and 5:00 AM.

[The following information identifies how the parking amendments are to be implemented for “Veterans of the Persian Gulf War” (King’s Highway and High Street):

- 1. Install new signage at the entrance and at the southeast corner of the lot, informing the public the parking rules of the lot.*
- 2. Placement of the “Resident Only” signs every four spaces using the double arrow for the interior spaces.*
- 3. Signage to be installed to identify the “Resident Parking Only” areas.*
- 4. Area on Map “F” Non-residential Parking – the eight (8) spaces in the middle of the lot.*
- 5. The remainder of the parking spaces in the lot for resident parking, these are the spaces that face both High Street and Ocean Blvd*
- 6. Area on Map “G” Eight (8) spaces for the parking of Motorcycles/Scooters– Resident parking only]*

“Veterans of the Korean Conflict” (Cusack Road & Ocean Boulevard Parking Lot)

Three (3) Hour ~~Two Hour~~ Non-Residential Public Parking in parking spaces that are not designated and posted as Hampton Residential Parking between the hours of 5:00 AM and 1:00 AM ~~7:00 AM and 10:00 PM~~

Overnight Parking is prohibited between the hours of 1:00 AM and 5:00 AM except in the 7 (seven) parking spaces designated and posted as "All Day/Overnight Parking".

[The following information identifies how the parking amendments are to be implemented for the "Veterans of the Korean Conflict" (Cusack Road & Ocean Boulevard Parking Lot):

1. *Area on Map "A" Designate the two (2) spaces (that are adjacent to the structure) as Loading Zones, between 6:00 AM to 5:00 PM, and then after 5:00 PM allow one (1) hour non-resident parking between the hours of 5:00 PM to 1:00 AM in these three spaces.*
2. *Area on Map "B" One (1) hour parking for non-residents. Eight (8) spaces in the southwest corner of the lot.*
3. *Area on Map "C" Three (3) hour parking for non-residents. Three (3) spaces in the southeast corner of the lot; in the area closest to Cinnamon Rainbow; and the four (4) spaces in the middle of the parking lot, totaling seven (7) spaces.*
4. *Area on Map "D" Overnight Parking – Seven (7) Spaces on the westerly side of the lot, in front of the Hotel – Available to residents and non-residents.*
5. *Area on Map "E" The Remainder of the lot would be designated for "Resident Parking Only". The sixteen (16) spaces that front on Ocean Blvd, and the fourteen (14) spaces in the northwest area of the parking lot that face the Condominiums.*
6. *Signage should be installed to identify the "Resident Parking Only" and the two spaces designated as "Loading Zones".*
7. *Placement of the "Resident Only" signs every four spaces using the double arrow for the interior spaces. Replace the signage for the overnight parking.*
8. *Install new signage at the entrances and at the southeast corner of the lot, informing the public the parking rules of the lot.]*

Install new signage that reads as follows for both the parking lots.

Resident Parking Sticker required in designated areas

No parking during snows storms (Kings Hwy and Ocean Blvd only)


“Veterans of the Persian Gulf War” (King’s Highway and High Street) As designated and posted (8 Spaces).




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Map of Hampton
