1. Department Heads and the Manager spent most of the latter half of the past week preparing for the arrival of Hurricane Irene.
2. State Parks has announced that they will hold an open house for their new Gift Shop in the North Pavilion on Ocean Boulevard on September 1<sup>st</sup> from 9 to 11 AM.
3. The State DOT is proposing actions to account for budget cutbacks on the State level. Proposed actions include no plowing on State Highways until there is at least 5 inches of snow on the ground; no plowing during certain portions of the late evening and early morning. Official word from the State has not been received concerning this,

but the Town should be concerned with any decrease in plowing services on State Highways.

4. Please keep an eye on Channel 22 during the week for announcements dealing with recovery efforts and disposal of debris, trash, and recycling schedules for residents should it necessary to change regular schedules.
