Mosquito Control

The Mosquito Control program begins the week of April 11, 2011 in the Town of Hampton. Crews from Dragon Mosquito Control will be checking swamps, salt marshes, woodland pools, ditches, storm drains and other shallow, stagnant water for mosquito larvae. When mosquitoes are found, the following insecticides may be used:

VectoBac (Bacillus thuringiensis israelensis)	Agnique MMF (poly-isooctadecyl-hydroxyl)
Natular (spinosad)	Mosquito Larvicide GB-1111 (aliphatic petroleum hydrocarbons)
Altosid (methoprene)	BVA 2 Mosquito Larvicide Oil (highly refined petroleum distillate)

A truck mounted sprayer will disperse Anvil (sumithrin) or Zenivex (etofenprox) along roadways. Road spraying may begin in June and continue into October. It is not possible to predict the schedule for road spraying in advance. The spray schedule is based upon mosquito surveillance data, disease test results and weather conditions.

If Eastern Equine Encephalitis or West Nile Virus is found in or near Hampton, then emergency spraying may be conducted using the following products:

Anvil (sumithrin)	Wisdom TC Flowable (bifenthrin)
Zenivex (etofenprox)	Cross Check Plus (bifenthrin)
Permanone (permethrin)	Mavrik Perimeter (tau-fluvalinate)
Flit (permethrin)	Suspend SC (deltamethrin)
Bifen I/T (bifenthrin)	

Emergency spray treatments may be conducted at the following locations:

Marston School	Tuck Field
Hampton Junior High School	Eaton Park
Centre School	Lou Brown Park
Winnacunnet High School	High Street Cemetery

It is not possible to predict if emergency spraying will be necessary. The spray schedule is based upon mosquito surveillance data, disease test results and weather conditions. Further communication will be given if emergency spraying is going to take place.
