VII. Town Manager's Report

1. The Town has not accepted the rules and regulations established by DRED for fines and penalties at the State Beach for violation of their rules, contrary to statements by State DRED Staff, published reports and TV news spots, the Police Chief and I are in agreement that these rules should not be accepted and the Police Department should not be enforcing them now or in the future.
2. The Galley Hatch curbing at the roadside by the Town and inside curbing by the Galley Hatch will be installed the week of November 4th, in order for the project to be finished without coming back to do additional construction in the spring.
3. I have requested that Legal prepare an amendment to the Town's Personnel Policy allowing veteran's preference in hiring. I have requested the amendment to be prepared and on the agenda for November 4th.
4. There are 10 minute parking signs on the west side of Ocean Boulevard from 19th Street to 1st Street moving south on the roadway. These signs are not in the Town Ordinance for traffic and parking. We do not know who installed the signs. Does the Board wish the parking limitations and signs to stay? If so then I will need to contact the State for authority to have the signs stay in place. If, that authority is granted, then Board will need to amend the traffic ordinance so that ticketing can take place for violations.
