VI. Town Manager's Report

1. Pursuant to an instruction from the Board, I have issued to each member as well as the Cable Committee, Assistant Town Manager, and Town Counsel a copy of the current cable contract for review and have requested suggestions on possible amendments for the cable renewal process.
2. I have been notified that the Police Department will be conducting night firing exercises and training during this week.
3. The State office of Emergency Management has announced an award of \$44,119 to Hampton for payment and support of Radiological Emergency Plan Training during the State fiscal year.
4. The Southeast Regional Refuse Disposal District has offered to receive residents from Hampton at their Household Hazardous Waste Collection in Brentwood with Selectmen permission and payment by the Town. It is recommended not to participate due to no funding.
5. The Assessing Department reports that the Towns taxable valuation has increased from \$2,781,983,500 to \$2,790,275,600 an increase of \$8,267,700 over 2014.
6. The State DRA has notified us that they are working on assuring that State Aid to Cities and Towns will be for the full budget year. These amounts are currently targeted for half of the year due to the six-month budget continuing resolution. Without further action by the State, our State Aid could be reduced by 50%.
7. I have ordered a curtailment on expenditures from the budget due to year-end estimates of remaining funds. The curtailment does not affect personnel services or warrant articles.
8. With the Board permission, I am looking to scheduling a Town auction of surplus materials for the month of October. We may be back to the Board for permission to sell scrap metals directly to a dealer in order to receive higher income.
9. I am currently projecting that my review of budget will be completed on September 11<sup>th</sup>.
