1. Thank you to everyone for taking the time from your very busy lives to vote in our annual Town election last Tuesday.
2. Those interested in applying for Veteran's, Elderly and Blind Exemptions should come to the Assessor's Office for the necessary required forms that must be submitted not later than April 15, 2016.
3. Residents of the Hampton Beach Village District who wish to apply for the alternate tax rate and billing will need to file the necessary application available at the Assessor's Office not later than April 15th.
