

Public Input Meeting - Feasibility Study for Hampton Transit Center & Route 1/Route 101 Interchange Redesign

The Rockingham Planning Commission is seeking public input as part of a feasibility study for constructing an intermodal transit center and park and ride facility at the interchange of US Route 1 and NH Route 101 in Hampton. Ideas being considered include:

- Design alternatives for a transit center and park and ride at the Route 1/Route 101 interchange
- Design alternatives for reconfiguring the interchange to be safer and more compact
- Expanded bus service on I95 and Route 101 between the Seacoast, Boston and Manchester
- Expanded bus service on Route 1 between Seabrook, Hampton and Portsmouth
- Summer shuttle connecting the beach to the town center
