

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1. Head northwest on Winnacunnet Rd toward Academy Ave. go 0.4 mi  
total 0.4 mi
-  2. Turn right at Lafayette Rd  
About 2 mins. go 1.5 mi  
total 1.9 mi
-  3. Turn left at NH-151 N/Post Rd  
Post Road is the road to the LEFT immediately after you cross the bridge into North  
Hampton  
About 10 mins go 6.1 mi  
total 8.0 mi
-  4. Turn right at NH-151 N/Portsmouth Ave  
About 1 min. go 0.3 mi  
total 8.3 mi
-  7. Turn left at Corporate Dr go 0.2 mi  
total 11.4 mi
-  8. Take the 1st right onto International Dr  
Destination will be on the right  
About 2 mins

## **Documents need to apply for Medicaid, TANF, and other State Assistance**

For every person in the family bring:

- Driver's license (if the person has one)
- Birth certificate
- Social Security card
- Utility bill (to verify the address where you live)
- Proof of 8 weeks past income e.g. check stubs
- All current bank statements—savings, checking, retirement, etc.
- Vehicle registration
- Medical insurance cards
- Proof of pregnancy completed by licensed medical professional, including due date and number of babies.

### **\*\*IMPORTANT\*\***

As of July 1, 2006, children applying for Healthy Kids Gold and pregnant women applying for Medicaid must provide proof of identity. These proofs are **NOT** needed for parents.

Teens 17 and over and pregnant women applying for coverage must provide one of the following:

- U.S. Passport
- Certificate of Naturalization
- Certificate of U.S. Citizenship
- State Driver's License with photo or identifying information such as name, age, sex, race, height, weight, eye color
- U.S. military card or draft record
- Government document with a photo or identifying information such as name, age, sex, race, height, weight, eye color
- School ID card with photo

For children 16 or younger, you may use one of items listed for older teens or provide one of the following:

- Military dependent's ID card with photograph
- School record that shows date and place of birth and parent(s) name and school name/address
- Doctor or hospital record showing date of birth, child's name and name/address of the doctor or hospital (such as an immunization record)
- Daycare or nursery school record showing date and place of birth and agency name/address
- Identification card from the local police department if it contains a photo, name and date of birth
