Hampton "What is it? Where is it?" historic points of interest brochure

- Betty Moore, former Executive Director of the Tuck Museum of Hampton History, will fact check the brochure content.
- The spelling of Centre School must be corrected ("re", not "er").
- Twelve items are still planned.
- Goody Cole's memorial entry should be expanded to include Founder's Park.
- The Cove grave has been supplanted by the crypt at the end of White's Lane.
