I. Call to order

V. Guest Speaker

Mr. Craig Musselman, President and Founder of CMA Engineers addressed the Committee. Mr. Musselman has over 45 years of engineering experience with an area of expertise in water supply, wastewater disposal and solid waste management. Mr. Musselman reviewed many of the issues being considered by the committee to include: waste disposal contracts; capacity of disposal companies to continue accepting Hampton's waste; the state of recycling and options to deal with it going forward; single stream recycling issues; curb side collection options such as pay as you go; utilization of organic collection services and composting; charge structures for items accepted at the Transfer Station; and public versus private collection as a matter of level of service. Mr. Musselman provided information about how other Town's in the State are dealing with solid waste and answered questions from the Committee members.

VI. Committee Discussion

The Committee members discussed the Town's budget and the Department of Public Works' (DPW) operating budget with Mr. Chris Jacob's, DPW Director. A request was made to have a representative from Mr. Fox and possibly other companies speak to the Committee at future meetings.
