Re: Fugitive Arrest- Carlos Jimenez

HAMPTON, NH- The Hampton Police Department, in conjunction with the US Marshal's Service has arrested and charged a Randolph, MA man for fugitive charges stemming from numerous warrants from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

On April 4, 2022 at approximately 2:17pm, the Hampton Police Department, along with the US Marshals, took into custody:

Jimenez was taken into custody from a residence on Dunvegan Woods Drive. He was wanted on several charges from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts that included:

- 1 Violation count of Marked Lanes Violation
- 2 Misdemeanor counts of Operating with a Suspended License
- 1 Misdemeanor count of Drug Possession
- 1 Misdemeanor count of Leaving the Scene of Property Damage
- 1 Misdemeanor count of Use of a Motor Vehicle without Authority
- 1 Misdemeanor count of Negligent Operation of a Motor Vehicle
- 1 Misdemeanor count of Operating Under the Influence of Drugs
- 1 Misdemeanor count of Allowing and Unauthorized Use of Motor Vehicle
- 2 Felony counts of Assault & Battery on a Family/Household Member
- 1 Felony count of Larceny
- 1 Felony count of Witness Intimidation
- 1 Felony count of Receiving Stolen Motor Vehicle
- 1 Felony count of Carrying a Dangerous Weapon
- 1 Felony count of Breaking & Entering a Building (Nighttime)

Jimenez was taken to the Rockingham County Jail where he will be held on preventative detention pending arraignment at the Hampton District Court on April 5, 2022 at 11:00am.
