I. NEW BUSINESS

- 1) Report from the Cemetery Sexton Brian Chevalier. Fall maintenance clean-up mode is going well. John Barvenik from the Legion suggested the flags come down after Veteran's Day. Trustees voted to keep them up all year long.

Motion by Chairman Blackwell to keep them up all year, Seconded by Trustee Preston 2-0-0.

Motion made by Chairman Blackwell to allow Mrs. Benjamin to take down the tree as a gift to the Town, Seconded by Trustee Preston 2-0-0.
