Contract Assessor

The Board heard a presentation on the hiring of MRI as the Town's Contracted Assessor. MRI has hired Mr. Tinker, Hampton's retired Assessor, who will be assigned to oversee the Town's required assessor duties for the Board of Selectmen as required by statute.

Police Dispatch

The Board heard a presentation regarding the changes required in the Town's Police Dispatch required due to the retirement of the senior dispatcher. Following the presentation the Board agreed that the changes are warranted in order to maintain the high quality of the Town's Police Dispatch.

Colony Motel

The Board reviewed the general problems with the current abandoned status of the Colony Motel on Ashworth Avenue. The Board indicated that they would address the issue in public session.
