 1. The defective pine trees on Academy Avenue have been cut down. The contractor is removing the trunk sections, as equipment is available. Once the trunk section are removed, the stumps will be ground, the chips removed, and the areas loamed and seeded.

2. High Street paving has been completed since the last report. Unfortunately, during the final pavement rolling a water main that was defective broke and the new pavement had to be excavated, the pipe has been repaired and new pavement added. In the near future, the section of the roadway around the water main break will need to be removed, the roadbed stabilized and new pavement placed.
3. Drakeside Road bridge abutment work has been completed. The roadway is open to vehicle traffic but caution is urged, as the roadway surface is gravel. New pavement will be added in the very near future. Speeds should be kept at 20 MPH until pavement is in place. Please remember that the roadway is still under construction and therefore still technically closed.
